Shakertown cuts shingles from shingle blocks for traditional random widths.



Imitators cut shingles from dimensional lumber, leaving you with repetitive patterns of only 2 or 3 shingle widths.

Shakertown cuts shingles with a traditional butt thickness, 30% thicker than other shingles providing longer life and a deeper shadow line.



Imitator shingles are cut thinner to shave costs while reducing protection.



Shakertown shingle panels have cedar in the keyway joints for superior aesthetics.




Imitators leave gaps between shingles, exposing matting and reducing visual appeal.

Shakertown panels use exterior grade adhesives in plywood presses to fully bond the cedar and exterior grade backer.
Cutting the panel is easy with no waste or extra work.



Imitators use a narrow glue bead and a whole lot of staples to keep everything together. They recommend you nail shingles to their panel backer before you cut.





Shakertown has an exclusive patent pending rain screen system that provides 98% drain efficiency.



Imitators put a fiberglass mat over exposure-1 plywood that can trap moisture between their mat and the house wrap.
